Operation Sovereign Borders

Operation Sovereign Borders (OSB) is a military-led, border security operation supported and assisted by a wide range of federal government agencies.

The OSB Joint Agency Task Force has been established to ensure a whole-of-government effort to combat people smuggling and protect Australia's borders.

Disruption and Deterrence Task Group (DDTG)

The DDTG is a multi-agency organisation led by the Australian Federal Police, and is headed by AFP Commander Lesa Gale.

The DITTG is led by the Maritime Border Command in the Australian Border Force, headed by Rear Admiral Peter Laver.
